LANDSCAPE MEMORIAL/HONOR OPPORTUNITY



Thanks to several generous and creative parishioners, there are new opportunities to remember family and friends who have died, as well as to honor those who are still living, on the grounds of St. Paul Parish. You have likely noticed the extensive landscaping work on our church property. The work includes setting up a new border around most of the church building. The border will require many composite beams to separate the border mulch from grass. For a contribution of \$25.00, a generous parishioner will engrave a beam with the name(s) of friends and family members. The names of both deceased and living people can be included on the same beam. A sample can be found outside the main entrance to church. 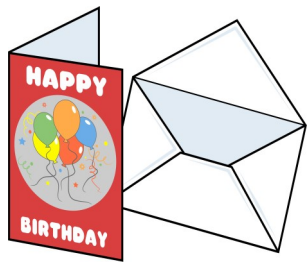


FESTIVAL UPDATE

St. Paul Parish Sacramental Information



Baptisms: Parents must be registered members of the parish for at least three months prior to setting a baptismal date, and must complete the baptismal preparation class. Classes will be held at a time that is mutually convenient for the parents and instructor. Please contact the parish office to set a baptism date and register for a class.



Marriage: Couples are asked to notify the parish office at least *six* months in advance. Catholics must be confirmed and active in the faith. Wedding times are to be scheduled no later than 1:00 pm. Even if a couple plan to choose their own vocalist, they are still required to meet with the pastoral leader at least six months in advance.



Anointing of the Sick: Due to medical privacy laws, family members are encouraged to notify the parish of any family members needing a visit, especially Anointing of the Sick. In addition to being available by request, this sacrament is offered after the 8:00 am Mass on the third Sunday of each month.

Policy for Visiting Clergy at funerals and other services: Please inquire in the office if you would like to include clergy from outside our parish. This policy can be applied to any activity here at St. Paul Parish.
