Frequently asked questions:

- What does this event cost? \$5 per child per day.

- How can I pay? Check or cash due the first day of attendance.
- What should my child bring? A water bottle (optional: extra set of clothes)
- Do my children or I need to be catholic to attend or volunteer? No! VBS is for all young people no matter their denomination to build their knowledge of Jesus and His love for us.
