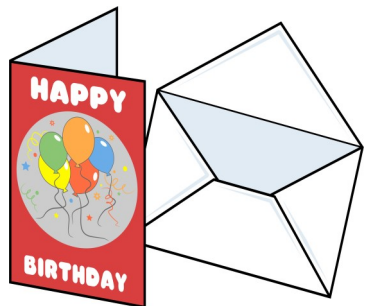
ST. PAUL PARISH SCHEDULE CHANGES

Until we have a successor to Pat Bartsch in the parish office, please call ahead to make sure someone in the parish office is available to assist you before you stop in. For this upcoming week, the parish office should be staffed during our usual office hours - 8:30 am to 2:00 pm, Monday through Thursday.

During the week of October 6th through October 10th, staff availability may be limited due to both Father JP and Deacon Jim attending the annual Clergy Congress of the Diocese of Green Bay. The 8:30 am Holy Communion Outside Mass and the 9:00 am Lectio Divina will take place on Thursday, October 9th, rather than Wednesday, October 8th.

GREETING CARDS MADE BY ST. PAUL'S MISSION TEAM

A wide variety of greeting cards are available on the card rack located on the north side of the parish hall next to the double doors leading to the portico. All proceeds are donated to support the Salvatorian Mission Warehouse. They are very thankful for all the donors who support them and contribute regularly, allowing them to continue their work.

The Salvatorian Mission Warehouse sends an average of two containers per month to Missions around the world. In these containers they pack life essentials such as food, clothing, tools, medical supplies, and other various necessities. Most of the donations for the containers come from corporate sponsors, but they use monetary donations to purchase containers and cover shipping fees and for requested items that aren't able to be donated.

So far this year, they have shipped 15 containers to Ghana, Guatemala, Haiti, Honduras, Panama, Peru, and Syria, which had approximately 625,000 pounds of relief goods inside.

St. Paul Parish Sacramental Information



Baptisms: Parents must be registered members of the parish for at least three months prior to setting a baptismal date, and must complete the baptismal preparation class. Classes will be held at a time that is mutually convenient for the parents and instructor. Please contact the parish office to set a baptism date and register for a class.



Marriage: Couples are asked to notify the parish office at least *six* months in advance. Catholics must be confirmed and active in the faith. Wedding times are to be scheduled no later than 1:00 pm. Even if a couple plan to choose their own vocalist, they are still required to meet with the pastoral leader at least six months in advance.



Anointing of the Sick: Due to medical privacy laws, family members are encouraged to notify the parish of any family members needing a visit, especially Anointing of the Sick. In addition to being available by request, this sacrament is offered after the 8:00 am Mass on the third Sunday of each month.

Policy for Visiting Clergy at funerals and other services: Please inquire in the office if you would like to include clergy from outside our parish. This policy can be applied to any activity here at St. Paul Parish.
